# Invitation to provide information to support the Action and express non-binding interest in the task

## 1 Background

Gas-fired heaters are a product type common in the EU, in particular in the northern part, where all homes need heating during the long cold season. The product type was selected on the basis of a priority setting exercise within the ADCO GAS that had looked at space heaters and boilers.

The product group comprises several subgroups of products including:

- Mobile and portable non-domestic forced convection direct fired air heaters
- Domestic flueless space heaters (including diffusive catalytic combustion heaters)
- Parasol patio heaters

Gas appliances like these are within the scope of the Gas Appliances Regulation (EU) 2016/426.

The Regulation requires that all appliances are designed to use the fuel efficiently. This requirement overlaps with the requirements from the ecodesign Directive, but the requirement in the Gas Appliances Regulation do not apply if the ecodesign Directive establishes such requirements for the product in case.

As there are no such specific ecodesign requirements for the three concerned types of appliances, only the requirement from the Gas Appliances Regulation applies.

The Official Journal of the European Union (OJEU) lists three harmonised standards applicable to these products. They are listed below:

- Mobile and portable non-domestic forced convection direct fired air heaters
  EN 1596:1998 including A1:2004: "Specification for dedicated liquefied petroleum gas appliances Mobile and portable non-domestic forced convection direct fired air heaters"
- Domestic flueless space heaters (including diffusive catalytic combustion heaters)
  EN 449:2002 including A1:2007: "Specification for dedicated liquefied petroleum gas appliances Domestic flueless space heaters (including diffusive catalytic combustion heaters)"
- Parasol patio heaters







EN 14543:2005 including A1:2007: "Specification for dedicated liquefied petroleum gas appliances - Parasol patio heaters - Flueless radiant heaters for outdoor or amply ventilated area use".

The final scope of this activity, including the selection of the specific product subgroups, will be determined in the inception phase based on the needs and requirements of the participating MSAs—and also on the basis of EC's/DG GROW's feedback.

In the course of the activity, the Market Surveillance Authorities of each participating country will take samples of Gas fired space heaters from the market and send them to a common test laboratory in order to verify their safety and compliance with the applicable requirements.

In the coming months, PROSAFE will issue an open Call for Tenders for a laboratory to carry out the testing. The Call will be published on the PROSAFE Website<sup>1</sup>, and will also be circulated by e-mail to all known competent European Notified Bodies. The sampling and testing is expected to be carried out during 2022.

PROSAFE is issuing this survey invitation to known competent test bodies to express their ex-ante non-binding interest in the task and provide baseline information useful for the preparation of a Call for Tenders.

## 2 Objective and Scope

This invitation does not entail any commitment, financial or otherwise, on the part of PROSAFE or of responders: it serves as a non-binding, informal instrument for the purposes of collecting information on the services to be provided and their availability.

It should be stressed that this invitation does not constitute a public procurement procedure in the sense of Directive 2014/24/EU. We do not require bids or proposals. Consequently, information provided in response to this invitation is not of a contractual nature, it will not be used for the selection of test laboratories and it will be treated as confidential.

By responding to this invitation, you simply declare your preliminary interest in working with us in the framework of the project. PROSAFE is not bound to invite, contact or contract only test laboratories responding to this invitation. Responding to the invitation does not automatically mean that you are eligible to be contracted for relevant tasks. This will depend on fulfilment of the requirements and criteria set out in the future Call for Tender. PROSAFE does not check eligibility or any other conditions at this stage, and your response does not entail entitlement to any assignments.

PROSAFE also reserves the right to use or not to use the data obtained in the future Call for Tender and at this stage PROSAFE does not check the eligibility or best value for money of the prices presented.

The products that will be subjected to the tests fall under the three different types mentioned as follows:

The tests should be specified with reference to the relevant clauses of the applicable standard which has been identified as shown in the table above.
