

# JAHARP2022 1st Press Release

## JOINT ACTION ON HARMONISED PRODUCTS 2022

PROSAFE together with **25 Market Surveillance Authorities from 16 EU countries** created 5 proposals that responded to the European Commission call to “Support joint enforcement actions - non-compliant products and implementation of Regulation (EU) 2019/1020”.

All five Joint Action proposals under the JAHARP2022 portfolio were awarded by the European Commission - DG Grow and EISMEA and they cover the following topics:

- 1. JAHARP2022-01 (ED/EL):**
  - Washing Machines
  - Professional Refrigerated Cabinets
- 2. JAHARP2022-02 (LVD - EMC - ED/EL)**
  - Solar panels and ancillary equipment
  - Pellet stoves
- 3. JAHARP2022-03 (LVD - EMC - MACH)**
  - E-car Charging Stations/Cables
  - Chainsaws
- 4. JAHARP2022-04 (ED/EL - LVD)**
  - Harmonisation of market surveillance
  - Mutual visits
- 5. JAHARP2022-05 (REACH)**
  - Asbestos in brakes

## SCOPE

*The consortium will be working towards:*

- enhancing market surveillance,
- strengthening coordination between MSAs,
- sharing and creating best practices,
- exploiting synergies in product testing, and
- improving safety and compliance with EU legislation.

*The main goals are:*

- 1. Keep non-compliant products from the Single Market;**
- 2. Support the application of Regulation (EU) 2019/1020.**



# PROJECT TIMELINE & KICK-OFF MEETINGS

The projects will last for 24 months and had an official contract start in April 2023 with kick-off meetings to take place in September - October 2023.

To ensure all activities are effectively launched in early September we have created a combo planning with multiple one-day long consecutive meetings with several scenarios.

The end goal is to organize resources in a most effective manner, avoiding overlap and drawing upon similarities between the areas under discussion.

All meetings will be online and will last about 4-7 hours so that we can effectively make progress right at the beginning of the autumn.
