What is JAHARP2022

7 coordinated product compliance verification activities + 2 horizontal activities until May 2025

Key Expected Outcomes

Dangerous products removed from the EU market, level-playing field for all market actors

Better, more harmonised product market surveillance, next to new skills and new knowledge for the EU MSAs



Transforming EU market surveillance and removing unsafe products from the European market

The Joint Actions on Harmonised Products - [JAHARP2022](#) have advanced towards their goal of increasing the level of product safety and compliance within the EU in the field of energy labelling and ecodesign, electrical safety according to Low Voltage Directive and Electromagnetic compatibility and Machinery Directive.

The JAHARP2022 is co-funded by the European Union and is formed by five autonomous yet synergetic market surveillance Joint Actions each with a duration of 24 months.

In total, 25 Market Surveillance Authorities (MSAs) from the 16 following countries participate: Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, Germany, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, the Netherlands, Portugal, Romania, Spain, and Sweden.

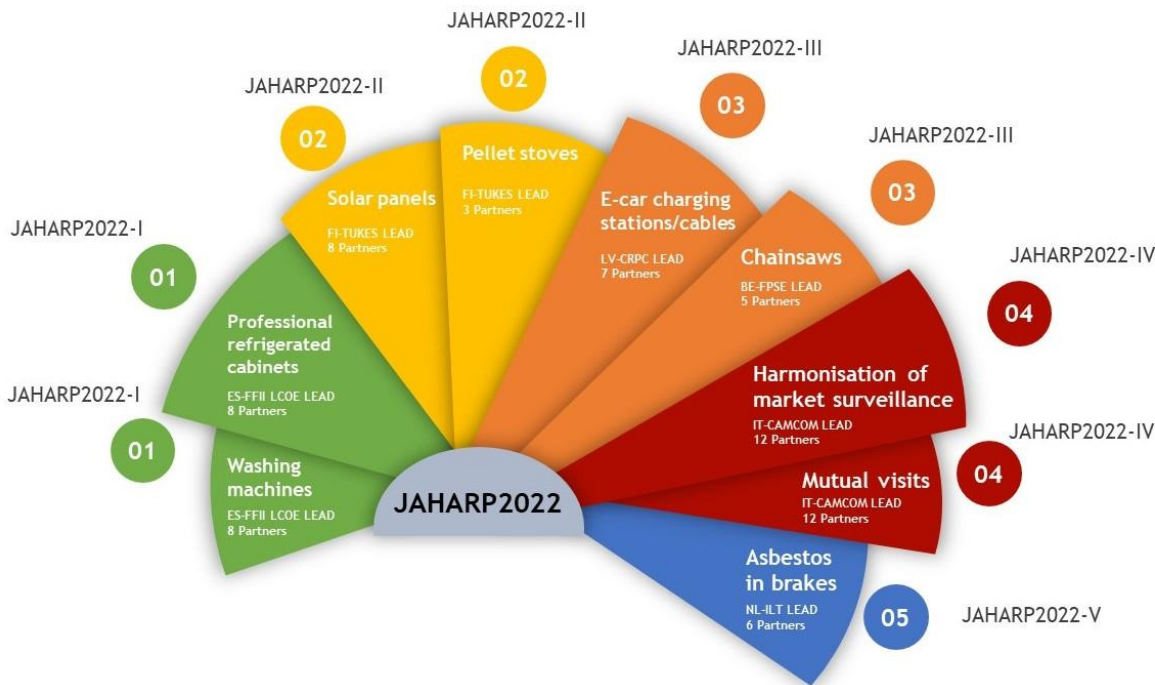

The JAHARP2022 activities

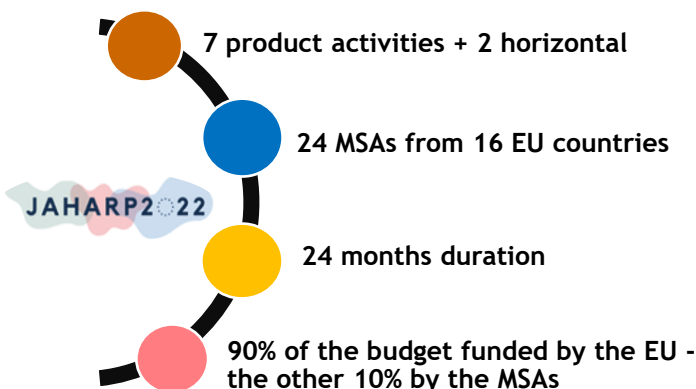
