E-car charging



Results and Recommendations

MSAs sampled 16 domestic EV chargers rated at approximately 11 kW with charging modes 2 and 3 and having a Type 2 (European) connector. 100% of the products failed the electrical safety testing and 50% failed the EMC testing.

Chainsaws




This EU-funded Action tested 13 battery-powered and corded models of chainsaws and mechanical safety issues were revealed, mainly weak handles and faulty chain brakes. For 9 chargers electrical spot tests were carried out, and 2 units had minor non-conformities.

Take aways



Before buying an EV charger, consumers should check the EU Safety Gate alerts and afterwards choose reputable installers.

Chainsaw safety standards need improvement, with more thorough testing. The EU accredited test labs' capability to carry out the chain brake tests should be increased.




The results reflect the targeted efforts of experienced inspectors to identify non-compliant products and do not provide a statistical picture of the market.




